Board Director Responsibilities:

Leadership, governance, and oversight

- Believe in and be an active advocate and ambassador for the values, mission, and vision.
- Approve Seeding Labs' strategic and material business decisions; oversee its legal and fiduciary responsibilities.
- Serve as a trusted advisor to the CEO.

Expectations for board members

- Serve a 3-year term, to be eligible for one reappointment.
- Allocate time for:
 - Quarterly, two-hour Board meetings, held remotely.
 - One annual meeting in Boston, in person.
 - ~6-8 hrs/mo on oversight, committee work, and networking for Seeding Labs.
- Inspire foundations, organizations, and individuals to donate by making a personal, annual contribution that is among the top organizations in your personal giving.
- Participate in resource development by taking on tasks suited to your comfort level and skills.
